YEAR END PERFORMANCE INFORMATION -DATES: MAY 26th – JUNE 1st INCLUSIVE

Our year end performance seems very far away; however; it will be here before we know it! Plans for storyline, music and costumes are currently being made, therefore, at this time we are asking for a commitment from each student as to whether or not they will be participating.

ALL students at Grace Academy are invited to take part in this production. **It will be a fun and exciting time for all of the dancers! Show week is the highlight of the dance year for everyone. It is a fabulous opportunity for your child to shine up on stage while learning about team work and dedication. The memories that it creates will last a life time 😊**

Participation involves regular attendance at all classes in the 3rd term (these will become rehearsals) and **the cost of a costume – see details that follow**

THE PERFORMANCE WEEK WILL RUN FROM MAY 26TH – JUNE 1ST INCLUSIVE – PLEASE MARK THESE DATES ON YOUR CALENDAR. WE ARE CURRENTLY PLANNING THE FOLLOWING:

TECHNICAL REHEARSAL – MAY 26TH - AFTERNOON AND EVENING (NOT FOR THE YOUNGER STUDENTS –details to follow)

DRESS REHEARSALS – MAY 27th, MAY 28TH , (ONE FOR THE YOUNGER STUDENTS AND ONE FOR THE REST OF THE SCHOOL – 5:30PM)

**PERFORMANCES – MAY 29th, 30th, 31st (EVENING),
JUNE 1st (MATINEE AND EVENING)**

YOUNGER STUDENTS (NURSERY, PRE-PRIMARY, PRIMARY 1ST AND 2ND YEAR BALLET, GRADE 1 BALLET 1ST YEAR, PRIMARY MODERN, GRADE 1 MODERN, GRADE 2 MODERN, PRIMARY TAP AND GRADE 1 TAP) WILL NOT PARTICIPATE IN ALL 5 SHOWS FOR EACH OF THEIR DANCES – DETAILS WILL FOLLOW WITH EXACT TIMES OF PARTICIPATION.

WE ASK THAT YOU MARK THE ENTIRE WEEK ON THE CALENDAR UNTIL FINAL DETAILS CAN BE CONFIRMED (please speak to Miss Knapp if you have questions regarding performance dates)

COMMITMENT

Please look at your calendars carefully! Due to the large number of students involved, and the great amount of planning and organization that go into the year end performance, we are unable to accommodate individual family schedules and conflicts.

DANCERS WHO CANNOT ATTEND ALL COMMITMENTS (REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES) DURING SHOW WEEK WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PERFORM IN THE SHOW. In the past we have had dancers ask to miss a day of performance/theatre rehearsal for any of the following: sporting events, school concerts, job training (senior girls), first communion, parties, and music concerts. Please look ahead and remember your commitment to the show when these events come up. Having a dancer pull out of a number once rehearsals have started is extremely difficult for everyone. Choreography must be re-worked and this can be very hard for the dancers.

Dancers should plan to attend EVERY CLASS in the 3rd term. Rehearsing a dance without all of the dancers present is confusing for everyone –dancers rely on the presence of others to work out their spacing and movements. If your dancer will be missing for any reason during the 3rd term please let us know ahead of time (ex. family holiday)so that we are well aware in advance and can plan our rehearsals accordingly. As always, please phone or email the Academy if your dancer needs to miss due to illness.

While this sounds like a lot, we would also like to encourage you!! IT IS A WONDERFUL AND EXCITING TIME!

PLEASE NOTE THAT CLASSES RUN AS USUAL ON THE MAY LONG WEEKEND (SINCE IT IS SO CLOSE TO SHOW TIME)

COSTUME DETAILS

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY. IT GIVES DETAILS OF THE COSTUME PROCESS FOLLOWED AT THE ACADEMY. THERE IS A LOT OF INFORMATION – IT IS NOT MEANT TO OVERWHELM YOU – BUT TO HELP YOU TO BE ORGANIZED AND INFORMED AHEAD OF TIME.

At this time we are asking for the following:

1. **A deposit of \$40 for each class that your dancer takes.** This deposit will be applied to the total cost of the costume.
2. A completed permission form and 'show contract'

PLEASE RETURN YOUR DEPOSIT/FORM NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 4TH.

This year, costumes will be handled in one of the following ways:

Catalogue Costumes:

Ready-made costumes are purchased from catalogues. Teachers will measure students in class to order the appropriate size. In some cases, alterations to these costumes are necessary as they are standard sizing and not made to each individual's size (eg - shortening a hem)

Alterations to ready-made costumes are the responsibility of each family, but we will provide a list of seamstress who are happy to help with this.

Costumes will be sewn by ESTA:

ESTA is a costume company that sews costumes for complete classes, specific to each dancer's measurements. Esta will come into the studio to measure dancers - days and times will be given out as soon as they are confirmed.

Costumes will be sewn by Erica Gilby, Carolyn Den Elzen or another Grace seamstress.

These seamstresses will be sewing for complete classes this year. They will measure dancers at the studio - days and times will be given out as soon as they are confirmed.

Each class will receive an email to confirm how their costume will be handled this year, as soon as decisions are final.

Costume Extras (shoes, socks, tights, ribbons etc)

Some classes will also need to purchase tights to go with their costumes. Ballet classes often dye their ballet shoes (with a leather shoe spray) to match their outfit. They are allowed to wear coloured shoes in class next year until they no longer fit. These details are all given out closer to the show.

Costume Invoices

You will receive an invoice for costume costs in early May. ALL PAYMENTS WILL BE MADE TO GRACE ACADEMY AND ALL COSTUMES MUST BE PAID IN FULL IN ORDER TO DANCE ON STAGE.

Costume costs can range from approximately \$90 - \$165 depending on the complexity and materials used in construction (costumes with a bodysuit are often a little more costly). Grace Academy works very hard to keep costs as low as possible, while still maintaining a high standard of quality and creativity. All supplier discounts are given directly back to the families and no extra fee is charged for the work involved in planning, sourcing materials or purchasing/ designing patterns.

A costume check will happen for each class, closer to the show, to double check for consistency and good fit.
